### CANADIAN INTERNATIONAL TRADE TRIBUNAL INITIATES INQUIRY

#### THERMOELECTRIC CONTAINERS FROM CHINA

Ottawa, Ontario, May 16, 2008—On May 16, 2008, the Canadian International Trade Tribunal initiated a preliminary injury inquiry into a complaint by Koolatron Corporation, of Brantford, Ontario, that it has suffered injury as result of dumped and subsidized imports of thermoelectric containers originating in or exported from the People's Republic of China. The Tribunal's inquiry is conducted pursuant to the *Special Import Measures Act* as a result of the initiation of a dumping and subsidizing investigation by the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA).

On July 14, 2008, the Tribunal will determine whether there is a reasonable indication that the alleged dumping and subsidizing have injured the domestic industry. If so, the CBSA will continue its investigation and, by August 13, 2008, will issue a preliminary determination. If this preliminary determination indicates that there has been dumping or subsidizing, the CBSA will then continue its investigation and, concurrently, the Tribunal will initiate a final injury inquiry. Anti-dumping and/or countervailing duties will be imposed only if the Tribunal finds that dumped or subsidized products are injuring or threatening to injure the Canadian producer.

The Tribunal is an independent quasi-judicial body that reports to Parliament through the Minister of Finance. It hears cases on dumped and subsidized imports, safeguard complaints, complaints about federal government procurement and appeals of customs and excise tax rulings. When requested by the federal government, the Tribunal also provides advice on other economic, trade and tariff matters.
